Whitney Community Center - Meeting and Performance Space and More!

The Whitney Community Center, completed in 2009, is available for a wide variety of activities. The building is managed by the Jackson School District in collaboration with a Whitney Oversight Committee. According to the wishes of Bill and Betty Whitney, it offers a wonderful, ADA-accessible, multi-use facility available to the local community in addition to the Jackson Grammar School children.

There are many options and spaces for public use in the Whitney. There is a large, multi-purpose Main Hall with a stage and options for seating up to 250. The Art Room is a bright room with working height tables and stools to accommodate approximately 20 persons. A small conference room, complete with a table and chairs, is an additional option for 8-10 participants. The large commercially designed kitchen is outfitted with a six burner gas stove, ample storage and countertop space with a pass through into the Main Hall.

The building is available for public use between the hours of 6am and 9pm daily except Monday thru Thursday between the hours of 8am and 3pm due to school classes and generally during special school programs and performances. These hours change during the summer months.

The WCC Main Hall features a stage and auditorium with full seating capacity of 250. Wi-fi speakers, microphones, and projector are available, as well as 250 chairs.



The WCC kitchen hosts a 6-burner gas stove and oven, a fridge, 3-bay sink and dishwasher. There are place settings for 125, coffee brewers, and a window to serve through to the Main Hall.
